When sampling blood for analysis, presence of a veterinarian authorized by the Purchaser is necessary. - Supplier has to provide transportation mean for delivery of heifers, that meets provisions of the Rulebook on loading and unloading of consignments of animal origin, animals, raw materials and animal waste in internal transport, export, import and requirements that a transportation mean must meet. - Supplier has to deliver certificate of disinfection of the transportation vehicle. - Supplier is obliged to deliver animals to the destination according to agreed dynamics.

- Supplier has to reimburse all costs incurred due to deaths or disease of animals in guaranteed period of one year. Proof is the official record of the authorized veterinarian with simultaneous notification to the carrier of the project (SIR), from veterinary station from the territory where the case happened.
- Costs incurred due to animal tagging (animal identification), issuance of documentation (animal passport, certificate of disinfection of vehicle, results of laboratory testing, issuance of pedigree certificate, certificate of pregnancy of heifer and insurance of animals) are borne by supplier.
- During delivery to certain locations, the supplier is obliged to submit supporting documentation for every delivered animal:
 - Certificate (confirmation of health status of animals – form "A"/1-14
 - Document on the report of movement, form "C"
 - Animal passport, form "D"
 - Certificate of pregnancy of heifers and date of insemination
 - Certificate of disinfection of vehicle (with date of disinfection)

Originals of this documentation will be delivered to each end user and copies of the documentation will be delivered to the authorized representative of the contract signer.

Delivery is in compliance with the legislation published by the Food Safety Agency of BiH, Veterinary Law of Federation of BiH and other valid legal and sub-law regulations.

Supplier is required to confirm whether offered pregnant heifers meet requirements provided in this annex. Any deviations need to be thoroughly explained on a separate sheet as an addition to this annex.
